Maths

Maths will focus on:

- Fractions
- Decimals
- Measurement—Money & Time
- Statistics
- Geometry—Shape, Position & Direction
- Problem solving & Reasoning.
- Multiplication



English

During Pentecost Term, we will be reading A Midsummer Night's Dream and The Girl who stole an elephant. We will be focussing on improving our descriptive writing through narratives and also learn about Myths and Legends. Reading will remain an important part of our lessons, looking at developing our comprehension and fluency skills.



Art

In Art this term, we will be learning about sculpture by studying Giacometti and Augusta Savage. Children will learn about technology in Art through photography. They will also explore creating their own clay sculptures!



Other Learning

Throughout the term, children will be learning basic conversational French..

We will continue to teach children how to stay safe online using resources from National Online Safety.

They will also learn about themselves physically and mentally as they grow, including how to maintain healthy relationships through our Relationships Education Programme.

Science

In Physics we will be learning about Sound, how it is made and how it travels. We will also be investigating Electricity and learning to make our own electrical circuits including switches. Children will learn about insulators and conductors and about the work of Nikola Tesla. In Biology, children will learn about their teeth and digestive system



History

The first week after Half Term is OLOL's History Week! Every year group has a different project and Year 4 will be learning all about the Suffragettes!



Geography

Children will be learning about locations and features of coastal regions, including tourism.

They will look at the North Sea Coast in Lincolnshire and the Amalfi Coast in Italy.



P.E

Year 4 PE this half term is swimming on a Tuesday. Please still come to school in PE kit as it is easier when getting changed. As previously mentioned, children need a large bag to put all their uniform/shoes etc in whilst swimming. After half term, PE lessons will be athletics. Days will be confirmed nearer the time.
